Legislative Update

Two SACRS bills! Divestment! Disallowed Compensation! Brown Act changes!

AB 1824 – Omnibus Bill

- Introduced by the Assembly Committee on Public Employment and Retirement on 2/7/2022
- Technical, non-controversial clean up of CERL and Education Code (STRS)
- PERS did not have any material for this bill

AB 1824 - CERL Changes

- 31452.7 Allows final benefit payment to corporation, trust, estate upon death of member
- 31641.4 Brings CERL into conformity with court ruling on military service purchases
- 31663.25 and .26 Allows for retirement date more than 60 days after application for safety members

AB 1824 - CERL Changes

- 31726 and 31726.5 Restructured for better clarity. No substantive changes
- 31761, 31762, 31763, 31763 Adds "natural" to clarify that continuances cannot be paid to an entity with no end (SBCERA idea)
- 31781 Clarifies calculation of active death benefit when there is an absence before the death (SBCERA idea)

AB 1971 – CERL Specific

- CERL substantive change bill
- Changes presented to SBCERA Board at its 11/4/2021 meeting
- Introduced 2/10/2022 by Assembly Member Cooper (SCERS retired member)
- Some sections removed due to opposition

AB 1971 - CERL Changes

- 31646 (amend) Clarifies that a member who returns from leave after caring for a family member may purchase service up to one year. Member pays both EE and ER contributions plus interest. Must be adopted by BOS (SBCERA idea)
- 31646.2 (new) Service credit for furloughs. Board may condition service on receipt of contributions. Up to 25% of normal work hours for up to 2 years

AB 1971 - CERL Changes

- 31680.16 (new) Retired member can be appointed to board or commission without reinstatement (SBCERA idea)
- 31725.7 and 31760 (amend) Allows members who retire for service to change option election if subsequently awarded disability retirement

AB 1971 - Removed From Bill

- 31525 BOR can make regulations without BOS approval.*
- 31730 Change DR to SR if BOR finds member is no longer incapacitated but employer will not reinstate
- 31838.5 Allow system to reduce DR when other system does not reduce.*
- * May bring back with new language

SB 1328 - Russia Divestment

- Applies to any BOR subject to PEPRA
- VERY BROAD PROHIBITION
 - Engaged in active business operations in Russia or Belarus
 - Engaged in oil-related or energy or power-related operations or contracts with another company in oil, energy, or power sectors of Russia or Belarus
 - Demonstrated complicity
 - Sells military equipment to Russia or Belarus

SB 1328 - Russia Divestment

- Audit provisions determine those companies that have business operations in aggressors
- Written notice to company
- No new or additional investments in company
- Liquidate within one month
- Report to Legislature

SB 1328 - Russia Divestment

- SBCERA sent letter of concern to authors requesting exemption for SBCERA due to substantial compliance
- SACRS letter of concern focuses on difficulty divesting and plenary authority of CERL boards to manage investments

AB 2493 - Disallowed Comp.

- BOR determines an element of compensation previously reported as comp. earnable is disallowed under PEPRA
- Employer is required to pay:
 - Full amount of any overpayments goes to system
 - 20% of actuarial equivalent present value of the difference between monthly allowances for projected life of member – goes to member

AB 2493 - Disallowed Comp.

- Statute silent as to who pays for actuarial calculations
- Only applies to peace officers and firefighters
- Mirrors CalPERS law that was passed in 2021 (SB 278)

AB 1944 - Brown Act

- Allows a board member to participate remotely without identifying the address and having the location open to the public
- Agenda must state the name of the member participating remotely
- Board must vote to implement the remote participation section

AB 1944 - Brown Act

- If board member elects to participate remotely, agency must update and repost the agenda
- Public meeting must be streamed
- SACRS sent letter of support for this bill
