RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the Service-Connected Disability Retirement with Supplemental Retirement Allowance of Sally Rae Cardinale - County of San Bernardino - Human Services.

Requested Benefit:

1. Service-Connected Disability Retirement with Supplemental Retirement Allowance

Staff Recommendation:

- 1. Sally Rae Cardinale is permanently incapacitated for the performance of duties and a disability retirement should be granted.
- 2. Sally Rae Cardinale's disability is service-connected based on the claimed injury(ies)/disease as listed in Exhibit A; therefore, grant a service-connected disability benefit.
- 3. Sally Rae Cardinale is not capable of gainful employment; therefore, grant the supplemental disability retirement allowance.
- 4. Staff shall initiate disability benefit payments with an effective date of October 12, 2019, the day after the last day of regular compensation.
